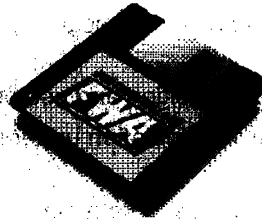
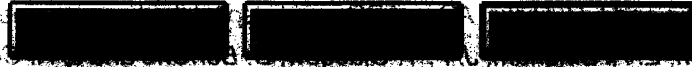

throughout the journal's existence. It also represents the profile of clinical investigation in Scandinavia through abstracts from Nordic meetings, and provides insight into disease mechanisms through original papers, invited review articles and technical notes.

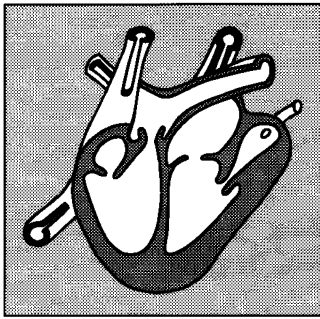

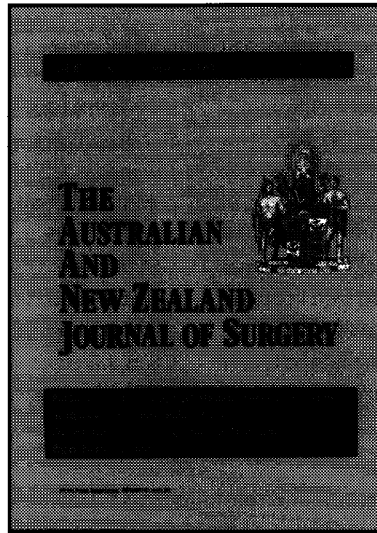

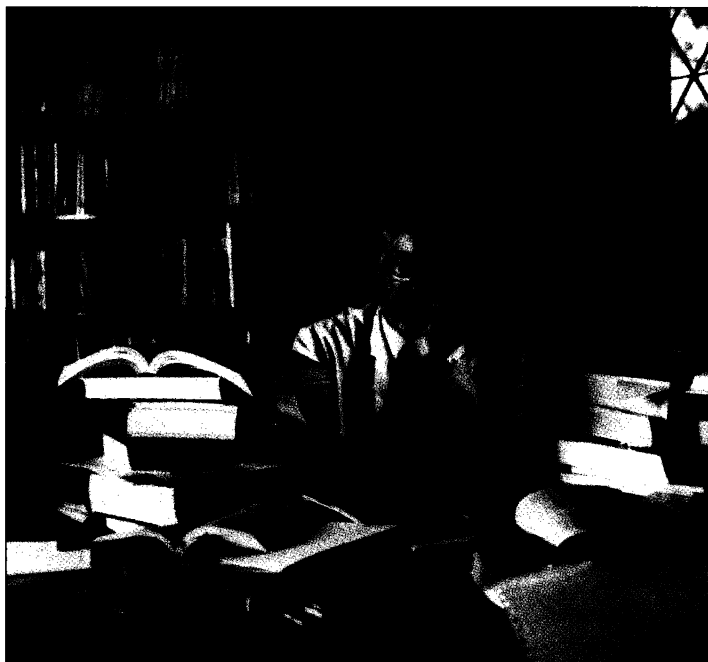
